- The popular annual parade will fill the streets into Old Town Saturday, July 18 at 10 AM, an opportunity for organizations, businesses and groups to celebrate everything that makes our community special, attracting participants from near and far. Last year 100+ floats participated in the parade, an event that often garners metro-wide media attention.
- The historic knighting ceremony, with roots in the late 1970's, will take place Friday, July 17 at 6 PM in Veterans' Park, recognizing individuals who have been of special service to the community.
- The International Archery Tournament with Nottingham, England, which began in 1956, is a unique sporting competition between archers in Sherwood and Nottingham, attracting 80+ archers of all ages every year for Sherwood's portion of the tournament.
- Two stages at the summer Festival will offer top-notch modern and medieval entertainment for people of all ages, attracting regional attention. Fun and culturally enriching medieval performances and activities will also take place on the grounds. Free kids' crafts and a castle building contest are always a part of the Festival. An additional stage and children's entertainment support the outreach of Voices for the Performing Arts, the Sherwood Library and the Sherwood Center for the Arts.
- Over 100 vendors, including several non-profits in the area, will feature a wide variety of shopping and activities to explore. Visitors will enjoy delicious food and a beer/wine/cider garden offering local selections. Sponsorships of \$300 or more earn a free basic booth (if desired) - or alternatively the ability to put out some advertising materials at the Festival.
- The Festival provides year-round leadership development opportunities for youth through the cherished Maid Marian Court tradition, an expanding annual scholarship program, facilitating the earning of scouting merit badges, providing a venue for the annual Bowmen competition silent auction, and hosting performance opportunities for school and non-profit musical groups. We also hold a Holiday Festival in December and assist with the spring Community Services Fair at the Sherwood fire station. And more!
