# PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION THOROUGHLY AND ENSURE YOUR PARADE PARTICIPANTS READ AND UNDERSTAND THIS INFORMATION AS OUR PARADE STAGING TIME AND LOCATION HAS CHANGED.

**APPLICATION:** All parade participants must apply, even if they are sponsors or vendors. There are two ways to apply:

Entries whose applications are received after Sunday, July 10, 2023, will be placed near the end of the parade, as the parade line-up will already have been set.

**AWARDS**: Awards will be given for the best entry in each of several categories - **see Parade Rules**. To compete for these awards, you will need to pre-register by July 8, 2022, and be ready to be judged at 9:00 AM

#### TIMING FOR PARADE CHECK IN AND LINE UP

7:45 AM Check-in begins

9:00 AM Entries to be judged must be checked in and ready to go. Judging begins.

9:30 AM All participants including walkers/vehicles/floats must be present and checked in.

STAGING AREA AND CHECK IN: This year, the parade will be staged entirely within the Langer's Entertainment Center parking area. ALL PARADE PARTICIPANTS INCLUDING WALKER DROP-OFF AND FLOATS WILL ENTER USING THE BACK ENTRANCE TO LANGER'S FROM LANGER FARMS PARKWAY (also known as the employee entrance). Entrants will wind their way around the building to the first stop location where they will sign in and receive instructions on where to proceed in the lineup. Langer's parking area is conveniently divided into four quadrants, as shown on the parade staging area map. Signs and volunteers will direct you in the staging area. Parade maps are available on our website at www.robinhoodfestival.org and will be available at check in.

## **RULES**

# 2023 Sherwood Robin Hood Festival Parade

- 1. The parade will start promptly at 10:00 AM on Saturday, July 15, 2023.
- 2. PARADE STAGING AREA WILL BE ENTIRELY WITHIN THE LANGER'S ENTERTAINMENT CENTER PARKING LOT. ALL WALKERS, FLOATS and VEHICLES will enter ONLY from Langer Farms Parkway at the EMPLOYEE ENTRANCE ONLY. Other Entrances will either be blocked or will be used as exits for cars dropping off participants. **Do Not** enter the parade staging area from SW Century Drive. Parade volunteers will direct you to check in as you wind your way around the building. After check-in, parade volunteers will direct you to one of four staging areas within the parking lot. Please see attached parade staging map.
- 3. Timing for parade check-in and line-up:
  - a. 7:45 AM Check-in begins
  - b. 8:45 AM Entries to be judged must be checked in and ready to go. Judging begins.
  - c. 9:30 AM All participants (walkers, vehicles, floats, and animal units must be in place.
- 4. Entries to be judged for awards must be pre-registered by July 10, 2023.
- 5. Each vehicle or float in the parade must have at least two designated line-of-site walkers for safety.
- 6. Adults must accompany children under 12 years of age on the parade route.
- 7. Riders on horses and ponies must be at least 14 years of age or be accompanied by an adult.
- 8. Please closely supervise and pick up after any horses, pets, or animals in the parade.
- THROWING CANDY OR OBJECTS FROM FLOATS OR VEHICLES IS PROHIBITED. For everyone's safety:
   Walkers may gently toss underhand or directly hand out candy along the parade route to prevent children from entering the street.
- 10. All motorized vehicles in the parade must be driven by licensed operators, 22 years of age or older, and vehicles must have liability insurance.
- 11. Entries are expected to be appropriate for viewers of all ages. Please use common sense with your parade entry, as we reserve the right to review and refuse any entry.
- 12. Parade participants are responsible for staging their entry and navigating the parade route in a safe and respectful manner. THE PARADE ENTRANT AGREES TO HOLD HARMLESS, THE SHERWOOD ROBIN HOOD FESTIVAL ASSOCIATION, SRHFA'S SPONSORS, INCLUDING THE CITY OF SHERWOOD, AND THEIR RESPECTIVE OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, AGENTS OR EMPLOYEES FROM ANY LOSS, CLAIM, ACTION, SUIT OR LIABILITY TO THIRD PERSONS; WHETHER DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY RELATED TO THIS EVENT.
