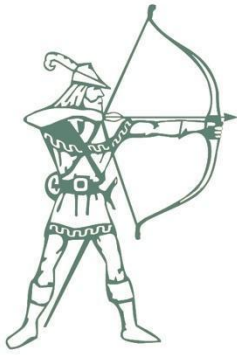
This scholarship was established in memory of James and Marie Ferry, early Festival volunteers who spent countless hours serving the community, especially in the 1950s.

If the recipient attends Sherwood High School, recognition will also be provided by the school. (Note: This scholarship is independent of the Maid Marian Scholarship.) Funds will be distributed to the recipient after the Sherwood Robin Hood Festival Association has been provided with proof of college or vocational school registration and a print-out showing completion of the first grading period.
